SWINGFORTHEFENCES raced three wide while slipping back a bit on the first turn, advanced while remaining three deep on the final turn, challenged outside rivals in upper stretch, continued willingly under strong right handed pressure through the lane, hit the front seventy yards out and gamely prevailed. COURAGEOUS ACT stalked the pace outside of J TOWN to the final turn, bid outside that rival on the bend, stuck a head in front in upper stretch, dueled through the lane and went willingly to the wire. CRYPTOGRAPH trailed on the first turn, moved within range while three wide on the final turn, finished willingly and was gaining on the top pair late. J TOWN sprinted clear early, set the pace from the rail, was headed by the runner up on the final turn, dueled to midstretch before weakening slightly late. GRUFF saved ground racing within easy striking range to the stretch but failed to produce a bid. ASCERTAIN (IRE) raced close up in midpack early but began to drop back on the backstretch.
