HOLY LIGHT chased racing three wide to the stretch, rallied through the final furlong and was up at the wire under urging. ROBYN'S SHARKEY set the pace under pressure along the rail to the stretch, inched clear in upper stretch, continued willingly but was caught in the final jump. TOMAHAWK CREEK pressed the pace from the two path to the stretch, remained a forward factor to midstretch, was outfinished. WINTER'S SHADOW raced four wide in midpack on the turn, went evenly through the stretch. RANSOM MEMORIES raced four deep while well back on the turn, had a mild rally without reaching contention. LIKEITLIKETHAT showed little. BANARK was outrun while racing inside. FLOMTASTIC chased from the rail to midway on the turn before tiring badly.
