PROVEN HONOR sprinted clear early, was headed on her inside by the runner up midway on the turn, dueled outside that rival through the lane and gamely prevailed under urging. SALTY N SASSY raced between rivals early, bid inside of the winner midway on the turn, dueled through the lane and just missed. PNUTBUTTERANDJOLIE saved ground chasing in midpack to the stretch, rallied willingly through the final furlong and was gaining outside of the top pair at the wire. SOLE OF THE CITY chased the pace racing three wide to the stretch, finished evenly. SWEET EVIL HARIET trailed to the stretch and had a mild rally without threatening. FAST BABY raced between rivals in the second flight to midway on the turn before giving way. BROKE TRYING showed little. SPECTACULAR MILLI raced in midpack on the backstretch before dropping back.
