Footnotes

SPRING WARRIOR vied along the inside for the early lead, took command leaving the backstretch and remained clear to the wire. DR T HUDSON vied between rivals in opening stages, continued just off the leader heading into the far turn and held on to place in the deep stretch. IRISH EMPEROR lacked speed in the early going, raced three wide in the far turn and gained ground to out nod rival for show. HARLEY D settled in near the back in the early going, saved ground racing along the inside in the stretch turn and steadily gained position in the late drive. PLANTOBEREADY tracked the pace in the backstretch, raced three wide in the far turn and came up empty in the drive. KING RED raced near the inside and failed to be a threat in the stretch. DU HOPE made a bid in the opening quarter and had nothing left late. FLY MR MAN raced up close to the lead in early stages and retreated after half mile.
