SIR BEAR was unhurried while trailing the field around the first turn, commenced his rally while saving ground on the second turn, angled out three wide in upper stretch, responded to right handed urging to sweep past the dueling leaders leaving the furlong marker, quickly spurted clear and was being geared down in the final strides. SKIMMING stalked DEPUTY FLAG to the second turn, moved up to engage that rival approaching the stretch, fought to a narrow advantage in midstretch, proved no match for the winner late and just held second. ECTON PARK settled off the pace early, commenced his rally in tandem with the winner while racing three wide on the second turn, had that rival hemmed in entering the stretch but could not keep him there, finished evenly and just missed the place. DEPUTY FLAG tugged his way up inside of rivals to take the lead entering the first turn, set the pace while in hand to the second turn, was headed approaching the stretch, continued willingly but was outfinished late. NITE DREAMER raced close up while three wide entering the first turn, remained within range to midway on the second turn before giving way.
