Footnotes

TOUCH TONE set the pace under a rating hold to the second turn, turned away COMPENDIUM without being asked entering the stretch, widened under heavy pressure to the wire. BUCKLE DOWN BEN was unhurried early, raced three wide on the second turn and was up for the place. DREWMAN was unhurried early, raced between horses while advancing on the second turn, finished evenly and just missed second. COMPENDIUM stalked the winner to the second turn, moved up to challenge approaching the stretch, couldn't match strides entering the lane and tired through the drive. SOLINGEN settled off the early leaders, moved within range while saving ground on the second turn, tired through the stretch. WHO DEVIL WHO was outrun. SIRPA chased the pace for the first half mile before tiring badly.
