THE CLIFF'S END placed forwardly while three wide, took over on the turn and held on well in the stretch under firm handling. FRIENDLY INCENTIVE reserved early, swung six wide into the stretch and finished well. BROKEN CONNECTION settled well, moved five wide into the stretch and kept on. REGAL HUM off slowly, raced far back, was fanned eight wide into the stretch and managed a late bid. FRIDAYNITE IN BOYD chased the pace while six wide, was urged on the turn, lodged a bid but flattened out in the stretch. MAIN ASSET was bumped at the start and displayed mild late interest. GLORY BE WILD leaned out at the start, was hustled along early, prompted the pace and weakened. HE IS QUICK was outpaced while seven wide and faded. O'LEE'S SONG showed little interest. NO PAPERS vied for the lead between rivals and faltered. MIX JUR retreated.
