Footnotes

RICH REWARD far back early while just off the rail, altered outside entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive, found her best stride upper stretch and was just up while full of run. LUCKY DAZ chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, made a bid along the rail, gained a short advantage deep stretch but was outfinished. DIAMOND STAR dueled from the outside for the early lead, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole but could not last. ALWAYS A CHAMP forced the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the drive and had a mild late gain. SHORTY up close early from between foes, had no late response. CHYNA ALISE well placed from the inside, had nothing left for the drive. PAR'S MIRACLE was no factor. PRETTY PASS was no threat. SEATTLE CONNECTION broke well from the outside, dropped to the rail when clear, dueled from the inside but gave way. ADD A DANCE was always outrun.
