WIDOWMAKER raced in striking position while five wide, moved six wide into the stretch and rallied. ITSAHORSEOFCOURSE stalked the pace and stayed on. CHYNA ALISE sprinted clear, was headed at the furlong marker and gave way late. GOVERNORS STAR saved ground, remained inside for the stretch run and showed mild late interest. SUNNY SHARK chased the pace while four wide, angled in for the stretch run and posed no threat. WHICH SONG broke outwardly, tried to bear out on the first turn and proved no factor. HUM ALONG LIL settled well but lacked a rally. L. M. DOLL was outrun. ANGELS N SAILORS never menaced. I SAY GLITTER was checked while in tight leaving the first turn along the inside and retreated.
