HOLLY AND FIR close up early while outside rivals, crept closer entering the turn, gained a clear advantage at the eighth pole and was clear late while under steady urging. NAVAJO WOMAN broke well from the inside, gained a clear early advantage, drifted out up the backstretch, remained clear entering the turn, remained forward through the stretch and was caught the final furlong. After a Stewards' Inquiry, NAVAJO WOMAN was disqualified for interference up the backstretch. CAUGHTUPNTHEMOMENT far back early, advanced inside, made a bid entering the drive and finished well but too late. GLITTERING VAL chased the early pace outside but could only improve position. MINGO I A forced the early pace from the inside, made a bid but faltered. FIRE TO ICE up close early, was bothered when NAVAJO WOMAN drifted out then tired. ITSAHORSEOFCOURSE chased the early pace from between foes, was bothered up the backstretch then tired. MALORYS HUMIN ALON chased the early pace from the outside, was forced over and outrun. SUNNY SHARK broke sharp from the outside, clipped heels when MALORYS HUMIN ALON was forced over, fell and lost rider.
