FINE AND RARE brushed at the start, settled while three wide, advanced on the turn, responded to pressure in the stretch and held sway late. BIG Z reserved while four wide, moved closer on the turn, moved four wide into the stretch and stayed on. KEN'S LIVINGSTON leaned out at the start, forced the pace and the lacked needed bid in deep stretch. DOWNTOWN CHARLIE gained the lead, was challenged into the stretch and yielded. OKLAHOMA HERO outpaced, entered the stretch three wide and posed no threat. IT'S A SIGNER never menaced. SHORT RANGER was always outrun.
