REGAL HUM allowed to settle early, tracked the pace up the backstretch, crept closer entering the second turn, circled rivals on the second turn, gained a clear margin and was clear late while kept to task. HAVE WE MET dueled from the inside with PAY THE TICKET and DUSLTLY WILD ROSE, battled with those two up the backstretch, remained engaged entering the drive but could not keep pace. FRIENDLY INCENTIVE unhurried early, advanced inside entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive but could not reach the winner. ELEVEN GAGE outrun early, advanced outside, responded and finished well but too late. PENTICTON up close early while between foes remained forward for the drive but had nothing left. DUSTY WILD ROSE was fractious in the gate, went six wide into the first turn, dueled from the outside and tired. GO GO CAT chased the early pace from the inside but had no late response. PAY THE TICKET dueled from between foes and gave way.
