SPIRIT OF WINTER gained a narrow lead, forged clear around the far turn and drew off in the stretch. QUICK STEVIE settled while three wide, moved four wide into the stretch and stayed on. STINGING RESPONSE saved ground, remained inside for the stretch run and displayed mild late interest. RAPIDO CORREDOR saved ground, angled out three wide into the stretch and produced a mild bid. BITTER CREEK failed to threaten. HAVE WE MET stalked the pace, was urged on the far turn and weakened. SYD LICIOUS was forwardly placed while three wide and dropped back on the far turn. HE IS QUICK was always outrun.
