PROSPECT KNIGHT saved ground, was moved off the rail on the far turn and showed some mild late interest. WOULD YOU outpaced, swung four wide into the stretch and lodged a mild bid. DOC'S FRIEND grabbed the lead, was headed on the far turn and gave way. WEST ALBANY failed to threaten. GLENBEIGH showed little. WAR WHOOP never menaced.
