RED FALCON broke sharp from between foes to gain a clear early advantage, remained clear entering the turn, responded to pressure when challenged on the turn, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while under steady urging. AT THE BRINK stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, challenged the winner entering the drive but could not keep pace. PRESS RELEASE well placed from the inside, made a bid entering the turn but could not match strides. TENFOLD forced the early pace from the inside, but had nothing left for the drive. SELECTED chased the pace from the outside but could only improve position. EXPLAINED could only pass tired ones. PERI PERI reared at the start and was no factor. STREAK was no threat. LOST IN GLITTER was no menace. PAPA'S DREAM forced the early pace and tired. MERKEL was never close. WILENTZ was pulled up soon after the start and vanned off.
