Footnotes

SHRADED EDGE was unhurried early and raced in the back of the pack, steadily began to advance position, edged up to the leaders heading into the far turn, duelled with rivals in the stretch while racing three wide, took command and in the late stretch and held clear to prevail. INDEPENDENT GEORGE showed good speed early and set the pace, began to match strides heading into the far turn while racing along the inside, continued bid in the stretch and held on for second in final strides. DUNSCOMBE saved ground early and raced near the back of rivals, raced four wide in the last turn, kicked in down the stretch and was gaining ground late. JACK AND MAX stalked the top two front runners, made a bid and advanced position but could not sustain bid in the drive. C S I IOWA stalked the early front runners, raced three wide in the far turn and failed to kick in the stretch. TOMMY AND BUSTER raced up close early and steadily began to weaken heading into the far turn.
