ONLY AT NIGHT vied outside a pair of rivals early, went clear a half mile out and angled to the rail entering the turn, widened a bit around the bend, was challenged by the runner up in upper stretch, dueled inside that one to the wire and gamely prevailed under urging. STORMIN SASSY vied for the lead from between rivals early, chased the winner around the turn, bid outside that one in upper stretch, continued willingly to the wire but could not push by. COUSIN MONTINEQUE settled off the early pace, split horses while advancing midway on the turn, went evenly through the lane. EOLICA trailed on the backstretch, remained well back on the turn, came six wide entering the lane and had a mild rally. BLUSH'N FROLIC passed a few tired rivals through the drive but was never a factor. CODING pressed the pace along the rail early, couldn't keep pace on the turn and dropped back. SCENIC WON showed little. KENTUCKY RUCKUS raced in midpack early, made a four wide advance early on the turn but failed to sustain her run and faltered through the lane. MISS TAY TAY raced three wide in midpack to the stretch, stopped.
