CART'S LAST CHANCE dueled from the outside for the early lead, took over entering the turn, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. FORZA DEL DESTINO stalked the early pace from between foes, advanced entering the turn, responded but could not reach the winner. STRAIGHT FLASH well placed from the outside, advanced entering the turn, made a bid and was gaining late. RUN WITH EAGLES outrun early, made a bid entering the drive and finished well but too late. JESS Z dueled from the inside but could not keep pace. BIG RAH was no factor. STORMY HIGHLAND up close early while inside, tired. NATTY BUMPPPO dueled from between foes and gave way.
