SPANISH LETTERS grabbed the lead, held well into the stretch and pulled away under a drive. CHARLIE JOHN chased the pace while three wide, moved three wide into the stretch and stayed on. BOOK OF LIFE stalked, was urged on the turn, proved no match and kept on. ROYAL EDGE saved ground, was angled three wide into the stretch and lodged a mild bid. THE KID DON never menaced. ODES OF PINDAR outrun while five wide, advanced on the turn and flattened out. TEA PARTY CAMPAIGN raced forwardly while three wide and dropped back on the turn. A LITTLE DIZZY was outpaced while five wide and proved no factor. EDGEM OUT was outrun, faltered and eased late.
