HE CAN DO THAT gained the lead, was challenged on the turn, dug in gamely and was all out under brisk pressure. A. K. A. BUBBA forced the pace, gained a narrow lead in the stretch but was outfinished. ARACIELO off slowly, saved ground, remained inside for the stretch run and produced a mild bid. RAGING GOLD settled, angled in for the stretch run and kept on. EDGY MEMORIE never menaced. SHADOW EDGE proved no factor. J. R. KIPPER flashed brief speed. FRIENDLY TERRITORY retreated.
