BITTER CREEK well placed from the outside, crept closer entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive and wore down rivals the final furlong. FLYING LEATHERNECK stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded upper stretch and was gaining late but could only gain the place. CALL FOR THE WILD broke cleanly from the inside, dueled for the early lead, gained a clear advantage at the eighth pole but could not last. MINGO GOLD dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained forward for the drive but tired inside the furlong grounds. PENTICTON could only improve position. JIMMIE THE JET could only pass tired ones. PAR'S LAST SPIRIT was no real factor. MIDNIGHT HANK bobbled at the start and had a steady fade.
