Footnotes

WILDANDCRAZYGUY dueled early, edged clear on the turn and held sway in the stretch. WAVERING SLEW raced in striking position while three wide, proved no match for the top one but stayed on. CHEROKEE CASINO settled well, entered the stretch three wide and lacked a rally. STOP THE SEARCH off slowly, was reserved, made a bid on the turn, moved four wide into the stretch and flattened out. IDEAL ASSCHER CUT saved ground, remained inside for the stretch run and proved no factor. ITS A BIG TOWN forced the pace and faltered.
