**Footnotes**

HARALDO (CHI) saved ground early and stalked the early pacesetters, made a five wide bid in the far turn and began to pass rivals down the stretch while remaining on the outside, was clearly best and drew clear while being ridden out. PROFESIONAL GRADE was well placed behind the early pacesetter, began to steadily inch closer to leader heading into the far turn, briefly took command at the top of the stretch but was quickly passed by HARALDO, continued bid but was no match for the winner. TUFF RUFF ANDREADY stalked the early front runners, angled out five wide in the last turn, continued bid down the stretch and steadily advanced into the show position. HOLD THE CHARGE stalked the early pacesetters while racing near the inside and lacked a late rally in the stretch. LEMON CUSTARD raced along evenly and was never a threat. ANTELOPE RIDGE broke sharp and was quickly clear, lead the way until the backstretch and gave way.
