SIR MOTT unhurried early while just off the rail, advanced entering the second turn, altered outside entering the drive and steadily drew clear under steady encouragement. FORGIVE YOUR SINS dueled from the inside for the early lead, battled up the backstretch with INCLUDE A TEXAN, dropped back slightly entering the drive, responded to pressure to come again for the place. INCLUDE A TEXAN dueled from the outside early, remained engaged through the second turn but could not keep pace. ART THIEF far back early, advanced inside, responded and finished well. BEAN could only improve position. SING IN THE STORM chased the early pace inside and tired. MCKENNA'S JUSTICE outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, made a bid but faltered in the drive. DUE TO GET EVEN was finished after a half.
