Footnotes

VENGEFUL VAL settled in midpack early, began advancing along the rail approaching the second turn, split horses in midstretch to take the lead and drew clear under urging. LAST OF THE VALLEY stalked VAGUELY WHO to midway on the second turn, made a bid for and briefly took the lead entering the stretch, proved no match for the winner but held the place. DUE TO WIN stalked the pace on the backstretch, made a strong bid for the lead while four wide entering the stretch before flattening out late. RUN FOR GOLD angled out five wide approaching the stretch and finished willingly. BABAI DANZIG was caught five wide entering the first turn, angled to the rail entering the backstretch, angled out midway on the second turn and bid for the lead while three wide approaching the stretch, weakened. MS FANCY PANTS was never a factor. CHIC LADY trailed to midway on the second turn, passed a few tired ones. CASH CRUISE was outrun. VAGUELY WHO was off a step slow, rushed up to set the pace along the rail entering the first turn, was headed approaching the stretch and gave way. SHE RULES THE MINT was outrun. MISS THE WAR flashed brief speed but was finished after the first half mile. ISTHATACLAIMGIRL was well placed before faltering on the second turn.
