LLOYDS LOVE raced forwardly while four wide, entered the stretch four wide, rallied under brisk pressure, gained the lead late and held on. SHIMMERING HOPE sprinted clear, maintained her advantage into the stretch but was worn down in the final sixteenth. MINGO ACE outrun while six wide, lodged a bid on the turn, moved six wide into the stretch and finished well. KAT'S HONEY reserved early, entered the stretch three wide and exhibited belated interest. WHY GO WEST settled well, advanced on the turn, angled five wide for the stretch run and lacked the needed kick. FERGIES GONE WILD saved ground and failed to menace. TINY TICA proved no factor. RETURN OF THE CAT was outpaced and faded. PEACHES TEACHES chased the pace while three wide and weakened. BARASSIE PASS showed little. SWINGING ROSE was never involved. BABY EXPRESS took no part.
