MUTAMENJA reserved, moved five wide into the stretch and showed mild late interest. CHEROKEE PAINT hustled to the front, was headed on the far turn and yielded. BULLCREEKROAD chased the pace three wide and proved no factor. PAIN TOLERANCE outrun early, was pulled up around the far turn and vanned off.
