WINNINGDANCER stalked the early pace from the outside, reached a striking position entering the second turn, gained command, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole and was well clear while under steady urging. WHENTHETIMEISRIGHT outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded but was no match for the winner while gaining the place. BANDI KAY unhurried early, advanced entering the second turn, responded but could not keep pace. ABO HAZEL allowed to settle early, advanced outside and finished well but too late. QUEEN OF THE POOL chased the early pace from the inside, duelled up the backstretch then tired. PIONEER WAY duelled from the inside early and tired. U S S INCHON had a steady fade. SPEEDY ESCAPE was finished after a half.
