### Footnotes

LADY HIGH INDY dueled along the rail to the stretch, came off the inside entering the lane and went clear, widened to the wire under an aggressive hand ride. FAITH KEEPER vied for the lead from between rivals early before settling into a stalking position, tracked from the rail on the turn, came through inside rivals entering the stretch, was no match for the winner late and just saved second. T'S FASHION FIND dueled outside of the winner to the stretch, was floated out a bit entering the lane, weakened through the drive. APACHE BABE raced within striking range from the two path around the turn, did not rally. LITTLE LADY T was steadied leaving the gate, raced three wide on the turn and was never a factor. BUTTER CRUNCH was angled to the rail on the backstretch, never threatened.
