INDIAN CHANT gained a useful lead in the initial stages, was engaged at the quarter mile marker and held sway through the stretch under vigorous right-handed pressure. PIRATESONTHELAKE broke sharply, was reserved early, moved five wide into the stretch, battled on well but could not get to the winner. MARKUM stalked the pace while four wide, remained four wide into the stretch, kept on but was outfinished. KINGSFIELD saved ground yet offered no contending bid. WILL E SCAT raced six wide early and never reached contention. DERBY ROAD was positioned five wide early, lodged a brief bid entering the turn but tired thereafter.
