STORMY SISTER broke well from between foes to gain a clear early margin, dueled through the turn, shook loose entering the drive, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear the final furlong under steady urging. DUCK RIVER hopped at the start, recovered to stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, responded but could not reach the winner. CHEESE A BAY chased the early pace from between foes, made a bid entering the turn and was gaining late. CAROL'S GIFT forced the pace from the outside but could not keep pace. LITTLE SHIMMER well placed from the inside, had nothing left. WINE TASTING ROOM up close from between foes, had nothing left for the drive. MISS BUSYBODY was no factor. MONITA was no threat. SOMEBODY NEW had a steady fade. IT'S ON was never close. TRULY SPARKLING showed little.
