LILLIE'S SONG broke sharp from between foes to gain a clear early margin, remained clear entering the drive, and steadily widen the margin while kept to task. MAKIN SOME WAVES up close early from the outside, responded when asked but could not keep pace. SUNNY SHARK chased the early pace from the inside, split rivals entering the drive and was gaining late. WHICH SONG far back early, responded to pressure and finished well. LADYDUG went evenly. CITY TAPPER chased the early pace outside but had nothing left. WIDOWMAKER was no factor. GLITTERING VAL was no threat. BIG CHEIFS SISTER showed little. CONN'S REVENGE was always outrun.
