Footnotes

SCENIC WON dueled for the lead from between rivals to mid turn, inched clear in upper stretch and held sway late under steady handling. REAL INTRUSION briefly vied for the lead from between horses early before settling into a stalking position near the rail, maintained her position to the lane, angled out, finished willingly but proved second best. AMBERSENT dueled for the lead while three wide to the stretch before weakening slightly. MATURE MISS raced three wide while well off the pace on the turn, came five wide entering the lane and had a mild rally. RUBIETTA settled off the early leaders, moved closer while four wide entering the stretch, finished evenly. IKNOWHOWTODANCE raced four wide on the turn and was not a factor. TANTALIZE showed little while racing near the inside. TALOEA dueled along the rail to midway on the turn before tiring.
