FOR COLTS AND GELDINGS, TWO-YEAR-OLDS WHICH WERE NOMINATED AND REMAIN ELIGIBLE FOR THE IOWA CRADLE. (Iowa Registered and Foaled). Weight: 121 lbs.; Non-winners of \$18,000 allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of \$15,000 allowed 4 lbs.; non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 6 lbs. *Late nomination of \$15,000 due at time of entry, of which 40% will go toward added monies. \$450 to pass the entry box and an additional \$675 to start. \$75,000 added of which 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, 2% to sixth. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to start will be given to those horses having accumulated the highest earnings at the closing time of entries. This preference will be utilized regardless of the ownership of the horses involved. This race will not be divided and will have a maximum number of twelve (12) starters. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. (S)

Footnotes

PEAKS OF LEGEND forwardly placed from the outset, moved to the front on the turn and drew off in the stretch. VOODOOVILLE veered in at the start, brushed FREEZE YOUR KELA early while racing erratically, moved four wide into the stretch, challenged briefly, was brushed aside but kept on. A LITTLE EDGY passed tiring rivals. BEWARE THE DEVIL chased along the inside, was in tight quarters going into the into the turn, dropped back and failed to menace. FREEZE YOUR KELA was brushed early while five wide by VOODOOVILLE and managed no rally. SIR RICHEY chased between rivals and lost his position on the turn. BOOTSCOOTN EXPRESS sprinted clear, was headed on the turn and yielded.
