BIG KENNY steadied early, advanced on the turn, moved five wide into the stretch and rallied under solid handling. BEHR STRIKE reserved early, swung six wide into the stretch and stayed on. CAPE TOWN DANCER chased the pace while five wide, gained the lead on the turn and was worn down late. FORGET TO REMEMBER saved ground, angled out four wide at the furlong marker and lodged a mild bid. ONE QUICK TRICK was void of speed and passed tiring rivals. FISTFUL OF MERCY was forwardly placed and weakened. MOUNTAIN FIR broke sharply, prompted the pace and faded. POLSON dueled and retreated. OUR HOPES FIR YOU never menaced. KLASSY PASS was settled while five wide in the early stages and proved no factor. CHARLIE JOHN took no part.
