TRA KELA prompted the pace, took over leaving the turn and edged clear. MY BELLA NOTTE dueled for the lead, was headed leaving the turn, proved no match and stayed on. NEVAEHS RAE saved ground, remained inside for the stretch run and kept on. BLESS MY SOUP reserved early, swung six wide into the stretch and exhibited some late interest. ADDEDUP NICELY chased inside and lacked a rally. DISQUALIFIED broke outwardly, was outpaced while five wide and proved no factor. WHY VAL WHY never menaced. JOLYNN'S FIVE GEMS showed some brief speed and retreated. GRAY EDGE was forwardly placed and weakened.
