COOPER'S SONG set the pace under mild pressure to the stretch, kicked away in upper stretch and remained well clear to the wire while under an aggressive hand ride. DAZZLING JANE saved ground racing within easy striking range to the stretch, finished willingly for the place while never a threat to the winner. SCENIC WON chased the pace racing outside of the runner up to the stretch before weakening. BAYOU CHA CHA split horses approaching the half mile marker while making an early run, pressed outside of the winner on the turn before tiring through the lane. STORMIN SASSY stumbled badly leaving the gate and trailed on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, angled out entering the lane and failed to rally. BLUSH'N FROLIC and KIDS 'N CATS were both outrun.
