KELA WAY grabbed the lead, held well into the stretch and prevailed in a game fashion. BOJI BROOK chased the pace while four wide, entered the stretch three wide and finished willingly. INO THEPATH settled well, moved four wide into the stretch and stayed on. TALENTED EAGLE stalked the pace and weakened in the late stages. TOUCH OF DUTCH was reserved and lacked a rally. RUTHLESS STYLE never menaced. DEMIDOFFS PROSPECT was outrun. MISS ROAN GLORY got loose behind the starting gate, was corralled, got off slowly and proved no factor.
