Footnotes

UH OH BANGO settled well, advanced on the turn, moved three wide into the stretch and drew off handily. WILD FOR GLORY stalked the pace while five wide, was urged on the turn, moved four wide into the stretch, brushed CAN IT BABY just past the three-sixteenths marker and kept on thereafter. I'VE GOT STEAM chased along the inside, remained inside for the stretch run and stayed on. DREW BOY raced forwardly in traffic, entered the stretch four wide and lodged a mild bid. MILES CITY off a step slow, angled in for the stretch run and exhibited some late interest. CAN IT BABY grabbed the lead, was headed leaving the turn, got brushed past the three-sixteenths marker and faded. T L S LIGHTNING broke outwardly and failed to recover. PLAY HARD BALL was outrun. HUMMINATUNE showed little. DENALI BLUFF leaned in at the start and was never a factor.
