BLUMIN EXUBERANT sprinted well clear early while under a hold, maintained a long lead on the turn without being asked, held sway late under left handed urging despite failing to switch leads through the lane. MISS VALEDICTORIAN chased the winner throughout and was slowly cutting into the margin late while proving second best. KEENE KITTY raced three wide while chasing the winner to the stretch before finishing evenly. IKNOWHOWTODANCE was outrun to the stretch, swung six wide entering the lane, lugged in while racing greenly in upper stretch, finished strongly when straightened but was much too late. SWEET HEATHER broke a step slow, passed only tired rivals. DONT BUG THE LADY chased the winner around the turn while saving ground before tiring through the stretch. PERFECT SURPRISE was never a factor. CLAMATO ROSE raced three wide while in midpack on the turn and also was never a factor. NOTED COMMENT showed little. ETOILE BLUES was outrun. LIL' TORNADO trailed throughout while being outrun.
