SUNNY SHARK bumped at the start, advanced on the far turn, led into the stretch, proved no match and kept on. SUDDEN RUSH chased the pace while five wide, surged up on the far turn, led into the stretch but was worn down late. SHORTY raced in striking position while four wide, lost her position on the backstretch and offered a mild bid in the stretch. RICH REWARD failed to threaten. CRESCO HIFLYER vied for the lead between foes, led into the far turn and flattened out thereafter. LOVESAVICTORY saved ground and proved no factor. HITY dueled early and retreated.
