FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS. Weights: Colts & Geldings 122 lbs.; Fillies 119 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of \$21,000 other than maiden or non-winners of any race at a mile or over allowed 4 lbs.; maidens allowed 8 lbs. No nomination fee. \$300 to pass the entry box and \$450 to start. \$60,000 guaranteed of which 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, and 2% to sixth. SUPPLEMENTAL NOMINATIONS AT TIME OF ENTRY WITH A FEE OF \$1,000 TO ENTER AND START. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Should this race not be divided and the entry number exceeds ten (10), high weights will be preferred. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second parts of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. No additional sex allowance will be allowed.

TWELVE HUNDRED gained the lead, held well into the stretch, responded to rousing and drew off readily. LET'S GET CRACKIN chased along the inside, lacked room nearing the seven-eighths marker when placed in tight quarters, steadied as a result and stayed on through the stretch run. KING CORAL reserved while three wide, entered the stretch four wide and kept on. KEG chased the pace while five wide, lodged a around the bid on the far turn and flattened out in the stretch. SOONERETTE was outpaced while four wide and showed mild late interest. TIOWAY showed little. SUN COUNTRY stalked the pace and dropped back on the far turn. SIX MILLION took no part.
