Footnotes

PARAPET set the pace from the rail, kicked clear in upper stretch and widened to the wire under steady handling. ORPHAN GAL pulled while racing just off the leaders from the rail on the backstretch, remained close up while saving ground on the turn, was up for the place despite failing to switch leads through the lane. STORMY CAROL pressed the pace outside of the winner to the stretch, couldn't keep pace in upper stretch, weakened and was outfinished for second while between rivals at the wire. SWEET LUCKY LADY chased racing three wide to the stretch, weakened and was outfinished for the minor awards. STAR ESCORT hopped leaving the gate, raced between rivals in midpack to the stretch, did not rally. TOUGH BETH was never a factor. FAITH KEEPER showed little while racing inside. ELISHA JOY trailed to the stretch, swung wide entering the lane, never made a bid.
