JUDY FAYE broke inwardly, set a solid pace under light restraint, edged clear on the turn while in hand and gradually extended her margin through the stretch under stout left-handed pressure. SWEET BONNIE pressed the early pace while three wide, was asked to improve on the turn, stayed on willingly but made no impact on the top one in the stretch. BITSY'S BLESSING was outrun, swung six wide into the stretch, responded and was going well at the finish. BIG OL COUNTRY GAL was void of speed, moved out seven wide for the stretch run and flashed good late energy. SOBER AT LAST was forwardly placed along the inside early, remained inside for the stretch run but lacked the needed kick. GOOD N GOLD was outpaced in traffic early and dropped back in the stretch. LAURIDIANI chased the early pace while five wide, faltered on the turn and finished a spent force.
