FOR COLTS AND GELDINGS, THREE-YEAR-OLDS WHICH WERE NOMINATED AND REMAIN ELIGIBLE FOR THE IOWA BREEDERS' DERBY. (Iowa Registered and Foaled). Weight: 122 lbs.; Non-winners of \$24,000 at a mile or over in 2005 allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of \$21,000 in 2005 allowed 4 lbs.; non-winners of two races other than maiden or claiming allowed 6 lbs. *Late nomination of \$15,000 due at time of entry, of which 40% will go toward added monies. \$200.00 to pass the entry box. \$400.00 to start on Saturday, August 27 with \$65,000 added of which 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, 2% to sixth. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to start will be given to those horses having accumulated the highest 2004-2005 earnings at the closing time of entries. This preference will be utilized regardless of the ownership of the horses involved. This race will not be divided and will have a maximum number of fourteen (14) starters. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. (S)

COUNT ROCK dueled outside a rival to the final turn, inched clear midway on the bend, was headed on his inside by the runner up in midstretch, gamely turned that one back to prevail under urging. KING FREDDIE was pulling hard and fighting the rider a bit while just behind the dueling leaders for the first half mile, split rivals in the two path on the final turn, cut back to the rail in upper stretch, bid inside the winner in midstretch but could not push by. MINGO MOHAWK raced well back to the final turn, was four wide while advancing on the bend, had a mild rally. SLEWS MOTEL raced four wide in midpack on the first turn, remained four deep while just behind the winner and outside rivals on the final turn, weakened through the stretch. WILL E SCAT settled off the early leaders, never produced a bid. SLEWEY ARMSTRONG raced just off the pace while three wide around the final turn before weakening. PERFECT POSE was outrun. ONE FINE AFFAIR dueled along the rail to the final turn, chased around the bend, faltered through the stretch.
