Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to start will be given to those horses having accumulated the highest earnings at the closing time of entries. This preference will be utilized regardless of the ownership of the horses involved. This race will not be divided and will have a maximum number of fourteen starters. (S)

LOVETHATLEGEND sprinted clear soon after the start, set the pace without pressure to the stretch, was set down approaching midstretch and remained well clear to the wire. WALKS LIK'N ANGEL settled well off the early pace, advanced to race in closest attendance to the winner midway on the turn, chased that one home, could not cut into her advantage but easily bested the rest. MY EASY CHARM trailed to the stretch before passing a trio of tired rivals through the lane to gain the distant show spot. DUMTELL bobbled leaving the gate and was never a factor while racing inside. T C REBEL ROUZER was outrun. THIS ONE FOR ABBEY chased the winner from the rail to midway on the turn before tiring badly.
