Footnotes

ULUVITNUNOIT raced four wide on the first turn while at the back of the compact, made a strong four wide bid around the second turn, hit the front approaching midstretch, briefly inched clear, just lasted late under urging. SEE HOW SHE RUNS settled within easy striking range along the rail around the first turn, saved ground to the second turn, came under a ride entering the bend, angled off the inside entering the stretch, finished strongly and just missed. TEJANO HONEY dueled outside of FRILLY FUN to the stretch, continued willingly from between horses to midstretch before weakening late. FRILLY FUN dueled along the rail to midstretch but also weakened late. PERSIMMON RIDGE raced three wide in midpack around the first turn, made a strong three wide bid early on the second turn, vied to upper stretch but failed to sustain her run. GIST raced close up near the inside to the second turn before tiring.
