Footnotes

DUST ON THE BOTTLE was unhurried while saving ground well off the pace to the second turn, rallied inside of SURE SHOT BISCUIT to take the lead seventy yards out and prevailed under strong right handed urging. MOUNT LEMON raced well back early, came six wide entering the stretch, closed strongly and gained the place in the final stride. SURE SHOT BISCUIT set the pace under mild pressure from DEPUTY FLAG to midway on the second turn, went clear approaching the stretch, remained clear to inside the furlong marker, continued willingly but could not contain the winner late and lost the place at the wire. MR ROSS stalked the pacesetters to midway on the second turn, advanced while racing five entering the stretch to loom a threat but hung through the drive. DEPUTY FLAG stalked SURE SHOT BISCUIT to the second turn, was asked to go after that rival entering the bend, couldn't keep pace approaching the stretch and gave way. CHERYL'S GAZELLE and KIPLING were both outrun.
