MISS VALEDICTORIAN was unhurried early while racing near the back of the pack, made a quick move along the rail on the second turn and came through inside of STORMIN SASSY to take the lead midway on the bend, was taken off the rail entering the stretch floating several rivals out, drew off through the drive under mild encouragement. TRUE TEAR DROPS raced within easy striking range to the second turn, advanced between rivals early on the bend, was floated out entering the lane and proved second best. TRICKY TAMI raced three wide while at the back of the pack around the first turn, rallied to loom a threat while four wide on the second turn, was floated out eight wide in a chain reaction entering the lane and failed to rally. STORMIN SASSY set the pace under pressure from GROOVY HERO to the second turn, continued to vie inside rivals around the bend, had the winner come through on her inside approaching the stretch, was floated out by that rival entering the lane and tired. GROOVY HERO pressed the pace racing three wide to the second turn before tiring badly. PICKIN THE PACE raced along the rail in midpack for the first half mile, stopped and was distanced.
