SAIL MISS GRACIE pressed the pace and weakened. MISS ABBEY LEE raced four wide and made a mild late rally in the lane. KIDS 'N CATS failed to respond. CALICO CREEK stalked the pace and tired. TOUGH MOONSHINE was far back and was outrun throughout.
